

Every pastor knows that every conversation is an opportunity for ministry – from chats after church to hospital visits; from door-to-door evangelism to prayer requests at the Bible study; from the phone call in a crisis to a tense elders’ meeting. God uses relationships in the body of Christ to build his people to maturity, and much ministry – and growth – happens in the context of one-to-one conversations.

Yet this ‘one-anothering’ ministry rarely gets the attention it deserves. Biblical counselling puts the spotlight on this aspect of church life and helps churches grow to maturity.

This 24-hour conference has been designed with busy pastors in mind. It will describe the biblical counselling approach to ministry and how it can serve the local church.

Speakers

We are delighted to welcome **Deepak Reju** of Capitol Hill Baptist Church to join our UK speakers **Steve Midgley**, **Andrew Nicholls** and **Ste Casey**.



Deepak Reju serves an associate pastor at Capitol Hill Baptist Church in Washington DC. He spearheads the biblical counselling approach to ministry that has become a key feature of their church life. Through the training of individuals and through their small group ministry, Deepak has helped the church develop a culture of ‘one-anothering’ ministry. A George Washington University graduate, Deepak also holds MDiv and PhD degrees from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He is married to Sarah and they have five children.



CONFERENCE 2 Topics & Skills

As well as being the place where the gospel is made known, church is the place where the gospel is lived out. Ephesians tells us that the church is God’s handiwork (2:10) through which God’s wisdom is made known even to the heavenly realms (3:10).



So it matters that we “make every effort” (4:3). The gospel must be heard in all its fullness and applied with all its power. The church community should be full of love for one another and equipped to do the ‘one-anothering’ ministry that grows us into maturity in Christ (4:11–16). This conference is about those things. It’s about doing church well.

CONFERENCE 2 PROGRAMME INCLUDES:

- ✂ Confidentiality in pastoral care – handling private information so that neither gossip nor secrets damage lives
- ✂ Getting started with hard issues – Deepak Reju will help us tackle the pornography epidemic and the perennial problem of conflict
- ✂ Learning by example – we’ll observe Deepak counselling someone live – a rare opportunity to see this ministry modelled

With bible readings from UK pastors and plenty of time for networking, discussion and personal reflection, this is a conference for pastors and church members, for those who counsel regularly and those with a more informal ministry.
