

Certificate in Biblical Counselling

Bursary Scheme

The bursary scheme is intended for students who cannot afford the full cost of the tuition fees for the Certificate Course in Biblical Counselling, and whose local church has insufficient funds to cover the student's shortfall.

The bursary scheme will normally match the contribution to their fees that a student's local church is giving them, up to 1/3 of the cost of the tuition fees.

The scheme is run on a first-come, first-served basis. Bursaries will normally be awarded for all the module(s) yet to be taken in that current academic year.

New students can apply once they have received confirmation of a place on the course.

Bursaries will normally only be granted to students intending to complete all three certificates in the course programme.

Application

To apply:

- 2. The student's pastor should email courses@biblicalcounselling.org.uk to confirm the level of financial support and outline the reasons the church is unable to meet the student's shortfall.
