Experiencing God



Some things are so much easier to say than they are to do.

'We want to apply the riches of Scripture to the realities of life.' It's a wonderful ambition, but how exactly do the Scriptures come alive in a person's life?

'We want an approach to personal ministry that speaks to the whole person — mind, heart and will.' Who could disagree with that, but are we really clear about the way thoughts, feelings and decisions fit together to shape a person's life? And how confident are we that our approach to ministry is effectively engaging all three?

'We want to experience God to the full.' Of course, but how? And what, exactly, do we expect an authentic experience of God to be like?

Jeremy Pierre is both a pastor and a professor of biblical counselling. Exploring the way people experience God is a key emphasis of his teaching. In a series of keynote addresses, Jeremy will show how the Bible leads us to experience God with all of our being — thoughts, feelings and will.

Yet this isn't some personal renovation project. We can only experience God as we should because Jesus Christ has gone ahead of us. He lived in relationship with God as human beings were intended to do. He earned the right to welcome each of us into this new humanity by faith.

Sins forgiven, design restored.

The heartbeat of the conference will be how to apply these life-transforming truths to ourselves and others — each in our own unique contexts.

The conference will include:

- Main sessions describing how to apply Scripture to human experience, a skill relevant to a wide range of contexts and ministries
- An emphasis on biblical counselling methodology
- An optional introduction to biblical counselling in the local church
- Time to network and reflect with others
- Conference sermon

The optional **masterclass** will provide an opportunity for a smaller number of delegates to engage with Jeremy's teaching in greater depth.

It will be of particular benefit to those who have some familiarity with biblical counselling, but no preparation is required and there are no specific requirements for attendance beyond having been at the first part of the conference.

Using worked examples and case studies, Jeremy will give a counselling-specific methodology for applying his teaching in our own contexts. Moving beyond principles to practicalities, through plenary sessions and small group discussions, Jeremy will help us develop our personal ministry in a way that will serve God's people wisely in our local churches.
